This activity will allow members to:

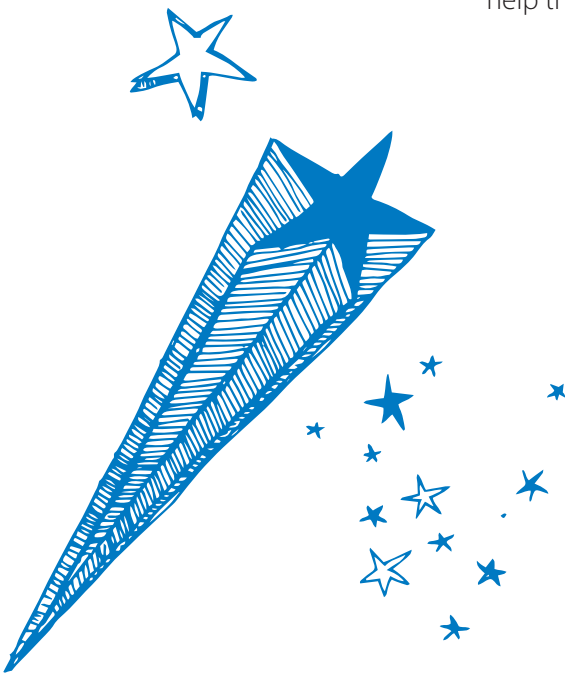
- Determine what they personally want to accomplish through the club experience.

How to lead this activity:

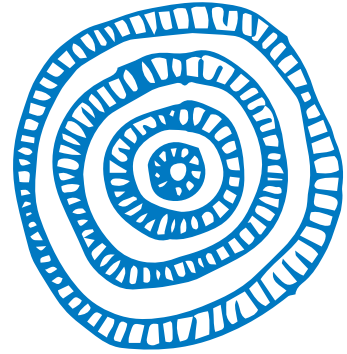
1. Decide whether members will complete the worksheet at a club meeting or at home.
2. Before the meeting, print out one worksheet per member—plus a few extra copies, just in case!
3. After everyone has completed the worksheet and turned it in to the club officers, use the information to help members learn new skills and have a great club experience.
4. Officers and advisors should review members' answers throughout the year and help the members by giving them opportunities that reflect their interests.
