

Sticker Voting

This activity will allow members to:

- Choose a service need in a fun and visual way.
- Connect with their fellow club members.
- Increase confidence and team building.

Materials needed:

- Flip-chart pages
- Stickers

How to lead this activity:

It's time to decide! This is an easy and fun way for your Builders Club to vote.

1. Write each service need category from the charting activity on a separate page of flip-chart paper.
2. Put each page where everyone can see it.
3. Give each member a sticker to vote with.
4. Tell each member to place their sticker on the flip-chart page for the service need category that he or she wants to do.
5. Once everyone has placed a sticker, voting has ended. The service need category with the most stickers wins.
6. If there's a tie, all members should vote on the tied options until there's a winner.
7. Have the secretary take note of the top three service needs. These should be handy in the future, for any discussions about new projects.
