**Term for members:** September 2026 – May 2027; renewable for a total of up to three years.

**Commitments to be a council member:**

1. Attend three of the four virtual meetings (to be held in mid-late September, November, January, and early April).
2. Review materials and documents and provide feedback when asked, sometimes prior to a meeting.

**How to apply:** Complete the online application form at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/Builders-Club-Faculty-Advisor-Council-application> between April 1 and May 31, 2026. *Members of the 2025-26 council do not need to re-apply to remain on the council in the upcoming year.*

**Requirements to be a council member:**

1. Applicant must be a current Builders Club faculty advisor with two or more years in this position. *A faculty advisor is a teacher, counselor, staff member or other adult appointed by the host school/organization to serve as the club's advisor.*
2. The Builders Club must be in good standing. This means the club is active and its renewal fees have been paid for the current year.

**Benefits for serving on the Builders Club Faculty Advisor Council:** We will send you Builders Club swag and provide a letter for use toward professional development points/hours that outlines hours served on the council.
