END-OF-YEAR CHECKLIST

THREE P'S FOR MEANINGFUL REFLECTION

To incorporate reflection that adds meaning and deepens learning throughout members' service experience, use the three "P's":

 Preparation: What did students learn from club activities about a community need or issue it wants to address?

- Processing: When students carried out the service project, how did they feel, what did they observe and how did they solve problems?
- Product: What were the results of the project for the community or organization — and how do members know this?



USE PARTNER FEEDBACK IN EVALUATION

Ensure deeper impact for members and service projects — by taking time for evaluation. This is especially important as you wrap up the service year. The <u>Assess Service Project Impact activity</u> incorporates a service partner's feedback and includes a worksheet to help discussion. Here are the basic steps:

- 1. Ask a representative from the partner organization or group to share feedback by answering specific questions. Invite them to speak to the club in person, by video or through a written statement.
- 2. At a club meeting, members hear the representative's feedback.
- 3. Have members form groups and complete the worksheet.
- 4. Allow time for the club to discuss what they thought went well, what they would change and how to work better as a team.
