MAKE YOUR COMMUNITY BEAUTIFUL

This year's Global Service Project focuses on beautification. Here's an example of the impact a Builders Club can make:

In the Bahamas, members of the St. John's College Builders Club noticed that their school's basketball court needed refurbishing. So they carried out the "Court-side Pride: Beautifying Our School Together" project last year. Members raised money through bake sales to hire an artist and purchase materials. Key tasks included organizing student volunteers to complete work, purchasing and installing privacy mesh, painting the mesh with the artist's design of the school's name, and refurbishing benches. They transformed the basketball court into a welcoming, attractive, pride-filled space for athletes, students, staff and visitors.
